IP500 - wireless, interoperable, smart and secure

IP500[®] Alliance showcases innovative smart building technology in Freiburg

Freiburg, August 29, 2018 – Members of the IP500 Alliance showcased their latest building automation devices and software through a trial installation as part of the Freiburg's "RegioWIN" Smart City Project. This installation was a trial-run for IP500 OEMs and partners to showcase the secure interconnectivity of their smart devices, solutions and systems before their official installation in over 100 commercial buildings throughout Freiburg's industrial sector.

Leading manufacturers, including Kingspan, Link, UTC, Honeywell, CoreNetix, PcVue, Microsens, and MC Technologies, collaborated to integrate and operate their products on the uniform and secure IP500 platform. The IP500 showcase installation demonstrated a range of state-of-the-art devices and programs in the fields of intrusion, access and light management, which allow facility managers to closely monitor and accurately control the operation of entire buildings.

The intricate network building automation equipment will first be trialed within one building, but will then be extended to encompass other neighboring structures as well as entire industrial areas located around the city of Freiburg. Over the course of the next several years, Freiburg's "RegioWIN" Smart City Project foresees the upgrading of 300 existing commercial structures in order to achieve the city's objective of becoming one of Germany's leading smart cities.
